
History & Invention

Bathroom history stretches back further than you might imagine. Originally, bathrooms were not developed with hygiene in mind, and the first records for the use of baths date back as far as 3000 B.C. At this time, water had a strong religious value and was seen as a purifying element for both body and soul.

Between 300 BC to date, a lot has changed on how we create access between humans and natural experience, creating a functional space and simplicity has been the idea for every invention, To the flush and cistern technology to the shower type technology, the unique bath tub experience for body and mental relaxation.

Phoenix wooden cistern with patented flush valve. It is lined with lead and can be installed either high or low.

1952

First plastic cistern made of PVC. It can be installed high or low. The cistern for WCs holds 14 litres of flush water, while the version for urinals holds seven. At 2.3 litres per second, the flush performance is impressive.




Duofix: universal and quick installation elements for all drywall construction tasks. Today, Duofix is the most widely used installation system in the sanitary industry.

Shower invention

The First Shower (Natural water fountain)


We begin our journey with our ancestors who lived in caves and huts that they built from natural resources. All those centuries ago, the only powerful source of water was waterfalls. Ancient tribal people would simply stand under the falling water to clean themselves.

Unlike today, where the majority of households have showers, people would have to travel miles to hunt out a waterfall, as this was a much more effective way of cleansing rather than bathing in a pool or lake.

The Ancient Egyptians

As society advanced, ceramic jugs were invented and the Egyptians were able to replicate the effects of a waterfall by pouring water over themselves. This was the first man-made way of showering.

The Egyptians also introduced an element of luxury and comfort to the bathing experience. Wealthy people in Egypt would order servants to bring jugs of water to dedicated shower rooms.






The Ancient Greeks

The Greeks adopted this idea and improved upon it by developing the first drainage systems. They invented a system that allowed water to be transported in and out of the rooms via lead piping.

And it wasn't just the wealthy few benefiting from this, they also built large, communal areas where everyone could wash together.



Roman Times


The Romans may not have built the first sewer system, yet they were pioneers in both plumbing and public health. For example, they created sewage systems for disposing of the wastewater – by 315 AD, Rome had 144 public toilets.

As a group of people, they had high standards of cleanliness. The Roman's constructed large bathhouses, not only in their native land, but across Europe.

However, the collapse of both the Roman and the Greek empires, lead to the technology used for showers to be put on hold for a few hundred years.

The First 'Modern' Shower

Fast forward to 1767, when the first patent for a shower was granted to William Feetham, a stove maker from Ludgate Hill in London. These early modern-day showers were powered by a hand pump and used less water than baths.





The First 'Designer' Shower

The development of the electric shower was a gradual process, starting with the English Regency Shower, and completed with the emergence of modern plumbing in the 20th Century. In the 19th Century, the English Regency Shower was invented by an unknown entrepreneur. This was the first hot water shower and was designed with a metal frame and painted to look like bamboo. It was however, still powered by a hand pump that pushed water through a tank.

Indoor plumbing was invented in late 19th Century, when people could easily use free-standing showers connected to a running water source.

Bath tub inventions


A quick overview of the first bathtub and plumbing systems foun. The invention of the bathtub and the invention of actual plumbing services date back quite a number of years ago, but are however very different from one another! The earliest discovered plumbing systems date back to nearly 6000 years ago near the Indus River Valley in India where archaeologists actually discovered copper water pipes in the excavation of the ruins of a palace in the vicinity. However, if we fast forward 3000 years ahead, this is about the time that the first 'ancestral' pedestal tub was unearthed on the island of Crete, it measured at five feet long, was made of hard pottery, and its shape resembled our modern 19th-century claw-foot tub.






The Rise and Fall of Bathing and Sanitation

From the years of 500 BC through until AD 455, the Roman Empire was championed for their daily rituals of bathing and staying clean. They very much raised the bar on acceptable sanitation and expected people of royalty and later on even the poor - to stay washed, clean and bathed. The Romans used bronze and lead pipes, marble fixtures, and went ahead to create a comprehensive sewerage system. During this era, the most common baths seen were public bathtubs, but also private baths, which resembled our modern indoor pools which usually encompassed an entire room. When the Roman Empire collapsed and the era's descended into the Dark Ages, sanitation virtually disappeared.





The Invention of the Modern Bathtub

When the end of World War I started coming to, it also brought with it a construction boom in the USA, and this seemed to increase the installations of 'modern bathtubs', sinks and toilets in many American homes. However, even though in 1921, only 1% of the populations' homes had indoor plumbing, as outhouses were still the norm in rural America.

In 1883, an American man by the name of John Michael Kohler invented the world's first bathtub. He took a cast-iron horse trough and added four decorative feet to the bottom of it and covered it in an enamel finish.



Something changed in the 1960s, with rising prosperity in developed countries and a pop culture focused increasingly on pleasure. Adorned with sunken bath.




The Invention of the Modern Bathtub

the Whirlpool was patented in the United States by Candido Jacuzzi in 1964), the archetypal '60s bathroom was the very model of a private "bagnio".
